*From our Pastor, Fr. George...***Dear Parishioners of St. Martha,
Sunday Sermon – Corpus Christi (The Body and
Blood of Christ) Sunday**

In the Book of Genesis, Melchizedek, a Biblical prototype of priesthood brought bread and wine to Abram and blessed him with this offering. Abram responded to this offering with a tenth of everything he had. Abram answered with generosity; offering yields offering, giver produces giver.

Biblical priesthood teaches us to be people who give rather than take. God's blessing is granted to those who offer gifts to others.

(1 Corinthians) Jesus offered bread in thanksgiving and said: *"This is my body"* and then he took the cup and said: *"This cup is the new covenant in my blood."*

Jesus is the priest of the New Covenant. He poured his blood on the cross for the forgiveness of sins. The Old Covenants, with Noah, with Abraham, with Moses, led to this New Covenant, in which Jesus is the offering and he is the priest. So, when Paul said: *"As often as we eat the bread we proclaim the death of the Lord"* he invited us to praise Jesus, the High Priest and to receive his Body and Blood which through his death on the cross became the Bread of Life for us. So, proclaiming the death of the Lord means believing that his death was an offering which we should never refuse.

In Luke, we hear of the multiplication of five loaves of bread and two fish feeding five thousand men. Jesus feeds his people, but he wants us to follow him for more than just feeding our hungers. He is the source of all goodness and the God to be loved. Satisfying the bodily hunger was a sign through which people should have recognized his divinity. It is through his divinity that we experience happiness and satisfaction with Jesus. Nothing else will give us anything more than that.

Let's say this thanksgiving prayer to Jesus, the Lord who comes to us through the Sacrament of Eucharist: ***Lord Jesus Christ, we thank you for your presence in this Eucharist: in the people gathered, in the priest, in the Word proclaimed and in the sacrament of your Body and Blood. May we always recognize you in our midst; may we come one day to see you face to face, to be with you for ever. Amen.***

Father's Day – June 19th

We send our best wishes to the fathers, we thank them for their fatherly love and commitment to their vocation in families, for taking great responsibility for their loved ones and for courage to serve the ones who are in need. Let's pray for fathers in the words of an Irish Blessing from Celtic tradition:

May the road rise to meet you, May the wind be always at your back. May the sun shine warm upon your face, the rain fall soft upon your fields. And until we meet again, may God hold you in the palm of his hand!

Nativity of St. John the Baptist

The calendar of the liturgical celebrations called "Ordo" instructs us that this year the Solemnity of John the Baptist's birth will be celebrated on Thursday, June 23rd. It tells us that this Feast dating from the 4th Century came to be celebrated, in accord with Lk 1:36, six months before the Lord's birth. Quoting Jn 3:30, St. Augustin found this date (near the summer solstice) appropriate because after the birth of John, daylight begins to grow shorter, whereas after Jesus' birth, it begins to increase.

Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Solemnity of the Sacred Heart falls this year on Friday, June 24th. The whole month of June is dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and many people pray the Litany to the Sacred Heart during this month. In this feast we thank God for Jesus' sacrifice, for his forgiveness offered to sinners and for an expiation that he did to pay for offences against God.

The prayer at the end of that Litany: ***Almighty and eternal God, look upon the Heart of Your most beloved Son and upon the praises and satisfaction which He offers You in the name of sinners; and to those who implore Your mercy, in Your great goodness, grant forgiveness in the name of the same Jesus Christ, Your Son, who lives and reigns with You forever and ever. Amen.***

Hear my prayer, LORD; listen to my cry for mercy.

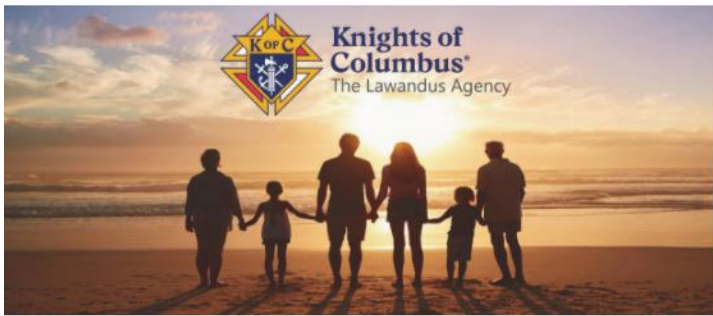

NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist - and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.” These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years. Nearly a hundred thousand Catholics will join together in Indianapolis for a once-in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the “source and summit” of our Catholic faith. The Eucharistic Revival begins with the Diocesan phase, from June 19, 2022, through June 11, 2023 and will include a Eucharistic Congress . Stay tuned for more information! 
