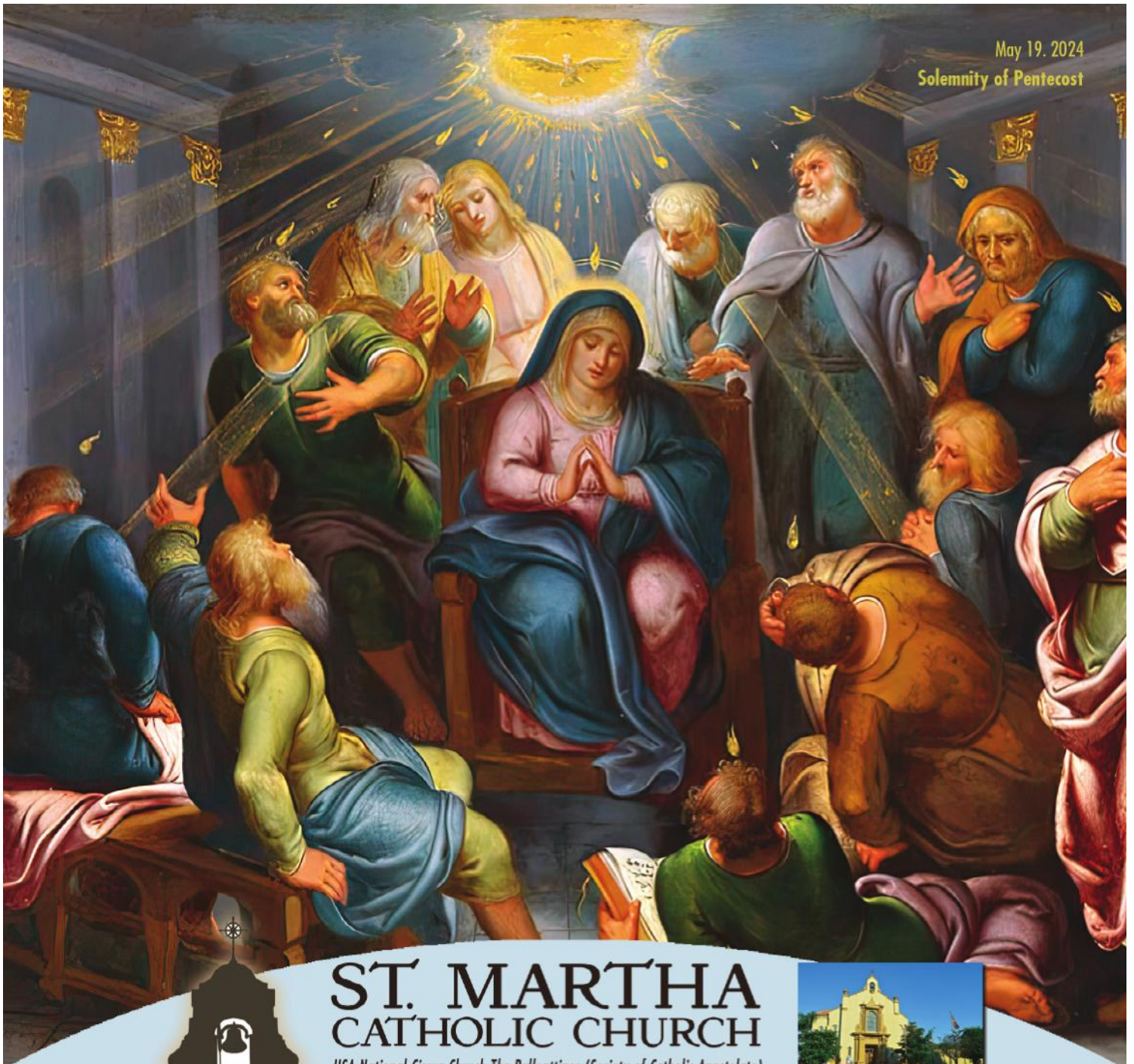

From Our Pastor, Father George
May 19, 2024 - Pentecost Sunday

From Deacon Vern Smith:

Today is Holy Spirit Day. We call it Pentecost because it has been fifty days since Easter. Pente is the Greek word for *five*, and pentekostos means *fiftieth*. The number is significant, but not a day about arithmetic and numbers. It is a day about the Holy Spirit of God coming to us and dwelling within us. It is a day to think of the fire of God's Holy Spirit dwelling within us.

In today's first reading, a selection from the Acts of the Apostles, you heard the words: *When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were filled with the Holy Spirit. . . .* The Holy Spirit, the Third Person of the Holy Trinity, is like a wind, like a flame. Like a strong wind or a gentle breeze, the Spirit can be present to you. Like fire, the Spirit can bring you light and warmth. *Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of the faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Lord, send out your Spirit, and renew the face of the earth.* Each one of you today, all of us together, can be filled with the Holy Spirit. We can be fired up and ready to renew the face of the earth. At least we can be fired up to renew our small portion of the earth with love.

Sacred scripture is telling you today that God is like a strong wind. Scripture is also saying that God is like flickering flame. Today's texts tell you that God is like love that can be seen with the inner eye and felt in the heart. God wants to fill your heart today with the fire of his love.

In the reading from First Corinthians you were reminded that *there are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit. [A]nd we were all given to drink of one Spirit.* There's another way to think about God the Holy Spirit. We can drink in the Holy Spirit and become refreshed, recommitted, rededicated, and ready to renew the face of the earth.

In the Gospel selection from John, you heard Jesus say, *Peace be with you.* Hear him say those words to you today and take him at his word. *Peace be with you!* Be at peace therefore. Be joyful today as the apostles were then on the first Pentecost when Jesus stood in their midst and greeted them. *The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord and [Jesus] said to them again, 'Peace be with you.'* As if to offer a warranty or a guarantee with that wish, Jesus said to them (and he says today to you), *Receive the Holy Spirit.*

This Holy Spirit, whose coming upon us we celebrate on this day, Pentecost Sunday, This Holy Spirit brings gifts – you've all heard of the gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel (or right judgement), fortitude (which is the courage all of us need), piety (understood as a mature and proper reverence), and the last on this list of gifts is what is called *fear of the Lord*, meaning a certain sense of wonder and awe. These are the gifts of Pentecost, confirmation gifts bestowed on the confirmandi, these are the gifts we celebrate today. These gifts enable us to work along with God in our own day for the salvation of our world. These gifts are the outpouring of God's love. The Holy Spirit is the mystery of God's love in our world.

If you ever ask yourself the question, *What is God like?* you ultimately come up with the answer that God is love. That is what all the fuss is about on Pentecost, that is what we are celebrating – the fact that God is love and that God's love is poured into us, God's love fires us up to do good things in this world, God's love warms our hearts. Just as human love on earth leads

to union of earthly humans, God's love in us unites all of us in one body, the body of Christ, the Church. God is love. We celebrate God's gift of love to us on this Pentecost Sunday.

We all need a measure of joy that only God can give. Christ promised to be with us always, even until the end of time. He is with us now. His being with us means joy and love, wind in our sails, fire in our bellies, warmth in our hearts. It means commitment and conviction poured into the very depths of our being. Christ's being with us means forgiveness of our sins and stupidity. Christ's being with us means that each of us has at hand a generous supply of the confirmation gifts he offered to his original disciples, the gift of the Holy Spirit who, in turn, brings gifts of wisdom, understanding, knowledge, counsel, fortitude, piety, and fear of the Lord.

Choose any one of these gifts that you like to occupy your time today. Choose them all, if you like, and delight in the enhancements they bring to you. But whatever you do, choose to dwell today on the great gift of fortitude. *[T]ake courage; be stouthearted,* says the psalmist (Ps 27). With the gift of fortitude, courage is yours to face the stress, sadness, anger, disappointment, and confusion that may beset you in these troubled days. But don't just think of yourself – your confusion, doubts, anger, and your fear perhaps for the future of the Church – think of your mission. After giving them the Spirit and expressing the wish that peace would be with them, Jesus said to his disciples (as he says to you today), *As the Father has sent me, so I send you.*

Consider yourself sent – sent out with a smile, with fire in your heart, with the wind of God's love at your back – consider yourself sent to bring the Spirit of Pentecost to the world beneath your feet, to a world in need of hope and help.
