From Our Pastor, Father George

May 26, 2024

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity MT 28: 16-20

From Deacon Bob:

Many theologians say one of the most difficult mysteries to comprehend or understand is our Triune God. For me, it has not been difficult to comprehend. As I share often, I have three favorite verses in the Bible. Two come from the First Epistle of St. John and the other is found in today's Gospel. Today, all three verses tie into the Feast Day. The three verses are *God is Love* from 1Jn, the second verse also from 1Jn is *see what love for us the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are! ... We are God's children now.* And, third we hear in today's Gospel which is *be not afraid, I am with you till the end of the age.*

God is Love. Since God was begotten, not made, or in other words always is and always was: God existed prior to the creation of the universe or man. Therefore, it always made sense, that if at one point in time there was nothing but God, God still had to love, if God was love. So it always made perfect sense that there had to be more than one part to God, so God could love. My greatest experiences of love were found in family. The nuclear family like God has three parts: The mother, father, and from them comes the child. A family is one yet has three parts. So it was quite simple for me to see those similarities of God and family. It made perfect sense. God is one but has three separate entities. A family is one but has three separate entities. *See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called children of God. Yet so we are!...we are God's children now:* this line reminds all of us that our Triune God has called us into God's family as adopted children. God is our Father; The Holy spirit sanctifies us, and the Son redeems us. This verse from 1 John reminds us, that even if we have no earthly family, we are part of the greatest family one can imagine. We are part of the family of God. *Be not afraid, I am with you always till the end of the age:* this closing line in the Gospel of Matthew reminds us even if we are by ourselves, Jesus is with us always as we are part of Him: his family! In those times of desolation and despair, God is still right with us. There is a prayer that the clergy are required to say almost weekly in Liturgy of the Hours. The prayer has a litany of all God's creation. It goes from the stars and moon to all weather events to all of God's earthly creation. Before the mentioned litany item, the line starts with *God Bless thee*, then the said item is mentioned. It is to remind us that God is fully present in all things around us all the time. Today is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Which proves God is Love. Jesus tells us we need not be afraid. Why? Because he is with us always! We are part of His family; he is not going to abandon us. In our most desperate times when we feel alone and abandoned, look for His sweet kiss of a breeze. Step into his warm hug in the sun light, His tender cleansing of the rain, His love song to us in a bird singing. His promise is: He is always there, always loving us. So we need not be afraid!

Suspension of 5:30pm weekday Mass until further notice - Having three priests in active ministry in St. Martha's parish during this time of holidays when one of us may be away for four weeks I need to **suspend 5:30pm weekly Mass beginning on Monday May 27, 2024.** I invite parishioners to 7:30am, 8:30am and 12pm Masses every day of the week!

Amendment 4 in the November ballot 2024 in the Florida State Law about abortion - This time, the Holy Spirit calls us to pray for the protection of life in the State of Florida, the Spirit of truth also wants to defend mothers and babies from any harm. We heard about this Abortion Amendment, of which the full title is **Amendment to Limit Government Interference with Abortion.** From the face of it you may think that it is to free Abortion from Government interference. But when you know that Florida State law, like the Heartbeat law, in fact helps to limit abortion, so amending to limit government interference with abortion — in truth — means getting rid of the Heartbeat law, which will be getting rid of the limit of abortion, guaranteed by the government, and allowing to legalize full-term abortion for any age without parental consent. It's way too extreme. This amendment to the Florida constitution would allow abortion up until birth, including when the baby is capable of feeling pain, and would eliminate laws requiring parental consent and safety protocols for women. Let's say *No* to this amendment.

Next Sunday, June 2, 2024, is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.
